

A genre-bending mashup of comedy, politics, history, and reference books. Stand-up comedian and TV host Greg Proops brings the same wily, boisterous

humor from his podcast to the printed page in this miscellany of uber-short essays on anything hip and cool from his perspective. Proops talks about the passions in his life, from baseball to poetry to movies to music to feminism, making snarky remarks on their oddity and hilarity along the way. His ostentatious verbosity is as deliberate as it's entertaining. There are plenty of interesting lists as well (which actually contain some historical and academic truth). Many of the lists take the form of baseball teams -- Proops assigns people, of certain categories, to different positions on a baseball team. The wittiest lists are perhaps 1) the "All-Time British Monarchy Baseball Team" (pg. 181), in which Elizabeth I is the Manager and Richard the Lionhearted plays Catcher; and 2) the "Dictators Baseball Team" (pg. 253), where Adolf Hitler plays the manager, Fidel Castro the pitcher, and Chairman Mao the designated hitter. Proops plays Augusto Pinochet at center field, because "Backed by the U.S., he willingly takes support and is a team player." Another great list, unrelated to baseball, is "Art I Wish I Had the Balls to Steal" (pg. 279). Mona Lisa is not on the list.
